



Representatives from numerous universities joined us, both physically and virtually, to exchange ideas, share practices, and cocreate strategies for the future.

The programme featured a rich variety of workshops and discussions, including:

- TTiDE marking the first-ever meeting of SGroup's Doctoral Schools, a milestone in our shared commitment to doctoral education.
- TTSMU exploring "Social Mission and Higher Education Engagement with Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI)". This session featured an inspiring keynote by Prof. Dibyesh Anand, Deputy Vice Chancellor Global Engagement and Employability at the University of Westminster, in conversation with Professor Alex Hughes, SGroup TTSMU.
- TT Africa focusing on partnerships and opportunities for deepened collaboration with African institutions.
- TT Americas highlighting initiatives and cooperation with partners across the Americas.

The sessions concluded with a set of actionable outcomes that SGroup will continue to develop and implement across its Think Tanks, ensuring that the dialogue leads to practical impact and long-term collaboration.

CAFÉ ON SERVICE LEARNING

Although 18 July fell during the summer holiday period at some universities, the SGroup Café on Service Learning and Community Engagement attracted an impressive 32 participants from across SGroup.

We were delighted to welcome Dr. Nives Mikelić Preradović from the European Association of Service-Learning in Higher Education (EASLHE) as the featured speaker. With her extensive expertise in service learning, Dr. Mikelić Preradović offered valuable perspectives on the state of the field in Europe, touched upon opportunities linked to EU projects and policy frameworks, and discussed the challenges and opportunities that institutions face when building impactful university-community partnerships.

This Café also carried special significance, as it marked the final meeting of the ECEM Project's Community of Practice (CoP). The ECEM project has focused on strengthening the role of service learning and community engagement in higher education institutions, while creating spaces for exchange and collaboration.

We extend our thanks to all who joined the session and contributed to the discussion.

CAFÉ ON EU ALLIANCES

On 16 April we were delighted to organise the Online Café, a best practice-sharing initiative dedicated to European University Alliances. This inspiring session was hosted by Kaunas University of Technology (KTU), an active member of the SGroup network as well as the ECIU University, brought together colleagues from over 10 countries, with 34 participants actively engaging in dialogue on shaping the future of higher education in Europe.

A special highlight was the presentation of the ECIU University experience, delivered by four insightful speakers:

- Olga Wessels, Head of the ECIU Brussels Office, shared the latest EU developments and how ECIU is working closely with policymakers to shape future educational initiatives and frameworks.
- Niall Power, ECIU University Director (University of Aveiro, Portugal), took us through the evolving story of the ECIU University—its vision, governance, challenges, and the pursuit of innovation across borders.
- Asta Daunorienė, Head of the EDU_Lab Center at KTU, highlighted how flexible learning pathways are reshaping education to meet rapidly changing labour market and societal needs.
- Vilma Karoblienė, Head of the Research and Innovation Projects Centre at KTU, shared valuable insights into research collaboration within the ECIU network, with a focus on the SMART-ER project and its sustainability.
